


The 5th Commandment Consequence


The 5th Commandment Consequence

I was born and raised in the church. My mother did all she could to keep me there as a single parent. But being a bright child, yet confused by the rituals, images and statues that I saw; and never seeing any images of anyone who looked like me, I soon became disillusioned and even angry at the church. At 12 years old I wrote a formal letter to the Archdiocese renouncing all things Christian.

My rebellion led me to study other religions like Buddhism, Hinduism and Islam. These doctrines shaped my thinking and seemed to foster even more rebellion. I virtually quit school and literally worried my mother to death.

At age 13, because of my reprehensible behavior I was labeled “uneducable” dropped out of school at age 14 and became a heroin addict. My addiction led to my incarceration. While locked away in prison I continued my studies. The more I studied, the more I learned about the African presence in the Bible.

It took years before I fully understood the value of an education, the importance of knowing my cultural heritage and the power of recognizing the God-spirit within me. In that quest I studied Moorish Science and learned more of the hybrid Doctrines.



The more I studied, the closer I got to Jesus/ Yeshua. I learned that most of the Biblical characters looked more like me than the media images I had been fed. Studying the African Heritage Bible reconnected me to Christ, I resumed my Christian walk and now feel compelled, to tell my story and defend the Gospel upon the hedges and the highways.

The Fifth Commandment Consequence is a story-telling, poetic walk through One Man's valley of the shadow of death. It indicates the importance of obeying the 5th Commandment of Moses which simply states: “Honor thy Father and thy Mother that thy days may be longer upon the earth, which the Lord, thy God has given thee.” It is an eye-opening poetic expose on the devastating consequences of disobeying God and a testimony to the rewards bestowed on a prodigal son.
